





## New legislation and processes: Immediate effect

- Changes in tax rates
- Medical credits
- Subsistence allowances
- ETI changes 50% increase in the value of the benefit which can be claimed by employers in respect of qualifying employees 1 March 2022.



### New legislation and processes: Proposed

- ETI penalty: Imposition of understatement penalty for employment tax incentives improperly claimed to prevent the abuse by employers of this incentive.
- Accommodating commission based on based on units produced: Reviewing the timing of accrual and incurral of variable remuneration.



### Tax research and reviews

 A discussion document will be published in 2022 on a personal income tax regime for remote work.
